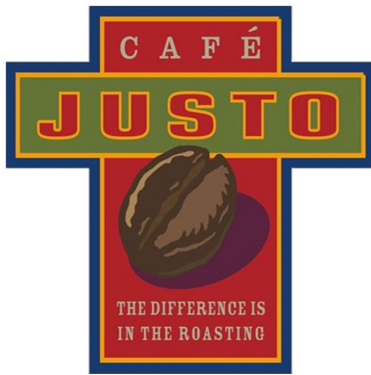


2026 BORDER-TO-BORDER DELEGATION:

- Visit members of the Café Justo Cooperative in El Aguila
- Tour the Mexico/Guatemala Border
- Visit the Scalabrini Migrant Center in Tapachula
- Visit local markets and a butterfly sanctuary
- See local waterfalls and other popular sites

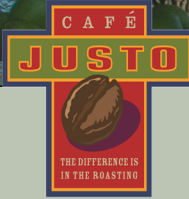
